

## MGIB-AD (Chapter 30)

### Who is Eligible

- AGR Soldiers with 3 year orders.
- Soldiers with at least continuous 2 year mobilization.
- Soldiers that have prior Active Duty service of 2-3 years with Honorable discharge.
- In addition to above service you also must not meet any of the ineligibility criteria.

### Ineligibility Criteria

- Service Academy Graduate
- ROTC Scholarship Graduate, receiving more than \$3400 during every year of ROTC program
- Previously declined in writing
- Active Component/AGR (Title 10) prior to 1 July 1985
- AGR (Title 32) prior to 29 November 1989

### Cost

\$1200.00

### Benefits – Who Gets What (Rates stated below are for full-time students – rates for less than full time will be pro-rated)

- Payment for consecutive service of more than 2 years but less than 3 years (FY11 payment rates) = \$1158.00 per month
- Payment for consecutive service of more than 3 years (FY11 payment rates) = \$1426.00 per month

### Optional Plus-Up program

- Any Soldier eligible for CH 30 may contribute up to \$600 for the purpose of receiving an increase to the amount of monthly CH 30 benefits.
- The additional contribution must be made while on Active Duty.
- Soldiers' are eligible to receive the additional Plus-Up at any time they are receiving Chapter 30 benefits as long as they are not on active duty.

### What Do I Need To Know

- You are allowed a total of 36 months of benefits for any one GI Bill program, and a max of 48 months if you are eligible for two or more GI Bill programs. You should contact the Department of Veteran Affairs (DVA) at 1-888-442-4551 to verify the number of months of benefit that you have used & the number of months of benefit that you have remaining.
- You must have completed at least 30 continuous months of qualifying active duty BEFORE you can collect any Chapter 30 benefits.
- While you are on Active Duty you can only receive Federal funding up to the cost of tuition and fees for your course/program. If you are using Federal Tuition Assistance (FTA) then you can only use Chapter 30 for the same class in the form of "Top Up". If FTA does not pay all the tuition and fees for your course/program then you can use your Ch 30 to pay the remainder owed for the tuition and fees.
- In accordance with (IAW) Title 38, USC, Ch 30 and paragraph 5.3.2, Department of Defense Directive (DODD) 1322.16 dated 18 June 2002, eligible Active Duty service members must make an IRREVOCABLE election to ACCEPT or DECLINE the benefit.
