The Idaho Army Honor Guard is an elite organization of individuals who are current members of the Idaho Army National Guard. The Idaho Army Honor Guard demands excellence in all we do and is comprised primarily of volunteer members. New Soldiers interested in joining the Honor Guard must meet the following requirements:

- Provide a Letter of Recommendation from traditional unit supervisor.
- State and Federal technicians must get a “Memorandum for Technician Supervisors” signed by their technician supervisor.
- Meet Army physical fitness standards.
- Meet Army height/weight standards and have a trim and professional military appearance in all military uniforms.
- Submit a DA 705 documenting the Soldier’s last three record APFT scores. A minimum of one record APFT score is required for Soldiers with less than three years service.
- Submit a passing certified height/weight statement within 30 days of application for membership.
- Be in the rank of E-6 or below.
- Have a fitted ASU uniform with black dress shoes and black overcoat.
- Possess a current valid driver’s license.
- Meet availability requirements set by the Area Coordinator.
