



RANGE 5

Multi-Purpose Training Range/ 4 Lane Combat Pistol Course

- Range 5 is a Multi-Purpose Training Range (MPTR) with a hard-wired control tower, and radio frequency-controlled targets
- It is approximately 2,000 meters deep with multiple target pits that provide a wide array of target scenarios
- The range has five lanes and will accommodate 16 firing tanks
- The target system for tank gunnery has screening panels and Target Holding Mechanisms/Tank Gunnery (THM/TG) positions are available
- Range 5 also has a standalone 4-lane Combat Pistol Qualification Course
- In close proximity to Snake River Training Facility



RANGE 6

Multi-Purpose Training Range

- Range 6 will support both offensive and defensive engagements up through HBCT Table VI
- Tanks may be paired together in order to implement the "wing-man" concept
- It is approximately 2,000 meters deep with nine concrete pits for Target Holding Mechanism - Tank Gunnery (THM-TG) and 38 concrete pits for M31 personnel target lifters (Plectrons), it also includes 5 Moving Armor Targets
- A mortar position is located north of the range for illumination during HBCT Gunnery
- Field artillery may also be used for the required illumination
- The range includes a tower, two heated barracks capable of sleeping 60 Soldiers, and a debrief building



RANGE 10

Multi-Purpose Training Range

- Range 10 is designed for firing HBCT Tank/Bradley Gunnery Tables and is used to facilitate vehicle zeroing and screening.
- It is approximately 4,100 meters deep with 22 concrete pits for Target Holding Mechanisms-Tank Gunnery (THM-TG), four M31 concrete pits for personnel target lifters and 5 Moving Armor Targets
- Screening lanes are located on the south side of the range
- This range will accommodate one firing and one dry firing tank per exercise
- One mortar firing position is available for tasks requiring illumination
- The range also has a tower, two heated barracks capable of sleeping 70 Soldiers, debriefing rooms, and small storage buildings



RANGE 26

Multi-Purpose Training Range

- Range 26 supports HBCT Gunnery Tables, and is also used to facilitate vehicle zeroing and screening.
- It is approximately 2,500 meters deep with 16 concrete pits for Target Holding Mechanisms-Tank Gunnery (THM-TG), 18 concrete pits for personnel target lifters, and 2 Moving Armor Targets
- This range will accommodate one firing and one dry firing track per exercise with a screening lane located on the east side of the range
- One mortar firing point has been established to provide illumination for night firing
- Field artillery illumination may also be used for the required illumination
- The range includes a hard-wired tower and heated sleeping quarters
- Tactical Training Base French located across immediately south of Range 26 on the south side of Range Road
